Montana Make It With Wool follows the National Make It With Wool Guidelines.

PLEASE NOTE: *Montana MIWW adheres to a strict content testing policy. ALL fabrics and yarns used in garments for ALL categories will be tested for wool content prior to District contests.*

Montana Categories:

Pre-Teen, Junior, Senior, Adult and Made for Others.

Entry Age:

Contestant's age on January 1, 2021.

ALL categories participate at the District level. Contestants enter and participate in District contests (October and November each year) based on the county where they reside.

If you have a conflict with the date of your District contest, you may participate in another District contest. Please contact the District Director before you send in your entry form (at least 4 weeks before the event).

First Place Winners in the Junior, Senior, Adult and Made for Others categories will advance to the State Competition held during the Montana Wool Growers Convention in Billings on December 3rd and 4th, 2021.

State Junior and Senior winners earn a trip to the National Competition!

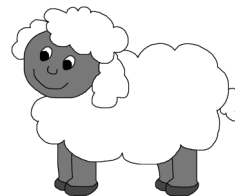
Prizes
