### **2021 Montana Ram and Ewe Sale Terms**

Approved June 7, 2021

1. Any changes to the sale book are provided on a supplement sheet included in the sale book and will be announced on the sale block as well.
2. In bidding on pens of rams or ewes, bids will be based on the price per head – not the pen as a whole. The auctioneer will settle misunderstandings or disputes as to bids.
3. All sheep on the grounds are held at the seller's risk until sold. Ownership changes when the sheep are sold in the ring. Sheep are held at the buyer's risk after the time of sale in the ring. The seller will ensure the sold animals are fed and watered until loading for transport, for up to 24 hours past the sale.
4. Terms of the sale are cash. Payment for sheep is due on sale day, unless the buyer is not physically in attendance. If the buyer is not present, payment must be sent to Frontier Stockyards, Inc. within 2 business days. All payments must be made by Credit Card, Wire Transfer, ACH, or overnight delivery of a check by way of Fed Ex or UPS. Any fees incurred for wire transfer, credit card, or overnight delivery of a check will be at the buyer's expense. No sheep can be released for shipment prior to the close of the sale without written order from the sale manager or clerk.
5. Certificates of Veterinary Inspection will be provided by the sale veterinarian, required for interstate transport and Federal Law. If additional health certificates, tests, or documentation is required for transport, it shall be at the buyer's request & expense.
6. The buyer must check the Scrapie tag and paint brand for accuracy upon loading of the animal for transport and report discrepancies immediately.
